MAIN USE

For residential and light commercial uses, both indoors and outdoors. Recommended for calcareous stones or unsealed marble. Easily strips acrylic finishes and built up coats of wax.

INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION



Test first on a small surface to assure suitability of coverings. Dilute 1 part of NU ZONE W into 1 to 3 parts of hot water for cleaning. Use full strength for excess sealer. Spread a coat of remover with a cloth or sponge. Apply a small area at a time and never let the solution dry on the surface being stripped. Every 10 minutes, scrub the surface with a white scrubbing pad to maximize the pe-

netration of the remover for a period of 30 to 60 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and absorb the solution with, if possible, a liquid vacuum cleaner or a dry cloth. Allow to dry completely before applying a sealer. Repeat this process if necessary until all sealer is removed.

LIMITATIONS

- Keep out of reach of children
- Wear safety glasses and gloves when applying
- Use in a well-ventilated area
- Avoid freezing
- Do not use on composite stone
- Varnished wood, plywood and MDF wood fibre mouldings should be protected
